# Registration Procedures

### WHAT?

SuperKids is a summer academic and enrichment camp for rising 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade Baltimore City students. Camp will take place from June 27 through August 5, 2016, Monday-Friday from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Camp will be closed on Monday, July 4, 2016.

### HOW?

Choose from one of the following four options:

- 📖 Register in person at our office Monday – Thursday between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. We will be open from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. on Fridays.
- 📖 Register by mail with included camp fee (MONEY ORDER ONLY). Application forms are available to print from our website at [www.parksandpeople.org](http://www.parksandpeople.org).
- 📖 Register on-line at [www.parksandpeople.org](http://www.parksandpeople.org). This option is only available to registrants who will be paying in full through credit/debit card or PayPal online.
- 📖 Spaces are limited and registration will close soon. Please register as soon as possible OR attend Mass Registrations on Saturday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> or June 4<sup>th</sup> 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at our office.

### COST

\$150 camp fee - *This cost includes the \$20 non refundable registration fee and \$130 camp fee.* We accept credit card or money order-**cash and checks will not be accepted.** Please include the participant's first and last name on money orders.

- 📖 \$150 camp fee (credit card or money order)

### What Else Should I Know?

**Space is very limited in camp, so please register your child as soon as possible!**

If you register your child by mail, be sure to complete the enclosed forms and send them to the above address, attention **Robyn Trayham**. Don't forget to include your money order (no cash or checks!). Incomplete forms will delay the processing of your child's application!

Financial assistance is available to those with certain income restrictions. If you would like to be considered, you must bring original income documents. Examples of income sources are paycheck/direct deposit stubs, Aid to Dependent Children, Social Security, food stamps and stipends. *Financial assistance requests will not be processed by mail – you must apply in person.*

### DIRECTIONS

FROM I-83, take Exit 7 toward Druid Park Lake Drive. The lake will be on your right.

CONTINUE on Druid Park Lake Drive as it bends around to the right, as if you are going to the Maryland Zoo. The name of the street becomes McCulloh Street.

MAKE A LEFT onto Liberty Heights Ave.

ON THE RIGHT, as soon as you turn, is the entrance to the campus; it is across from the Shaarei Tifiloh Synagogue.

TURN RIGHT into the driveway and drive up to the Stone House; there is visitor parking in front of the Stone House. Walk down to the Sally & Butch Michel Center for Parks & People.
