## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES WITH SUPERKIDS CAMP

### *What is SuperKids Camp?*

SuperKids Camp is a six-week summer reading enrichment program. Now celebrating our 13th year of service to the Baltimore City community, SuperKids Camp has served more than 15,000 children. Last year we were honored to be the recipient of the Johns Hopkins Center for Summer Learning's Excellence in Summer Learning Award which "recognizes outstanding summer programs that demonstrate excellence in accelerating academic achievement and promoting positive development for young people."

**SuperKids Camp 2010** will take place from June 28, 2010 through August 6, 2010 elementary school students attending a Baltimore City Public School. Camp will run Monday – Friday from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

### Volunteer Responsibilities

- **Assistant to Site Coordinator**  
DUTIES: Responsible for assisting in day-to-day management and leadership of SuperKids Camp site of 60 – 120 students and 6 – 12 staff.
- **Reading Counselor Assistant**  
DUTIES: Serve as assistant to Reading Counselor for a group of approximately 10 students. Assist with food distribution, chaperoning on field trips. Provide positive role models and guidance for students.
- **Administrative Assistant**  
DUTIES: Provide administrative support and assist at SuperKids Camp office. Work closely with staff in day-to-day operations. Start date availability in May 2010.

# General Information



- **QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS:**

SuperKids Camp volunteers must be highly motivated, energetic, and committed to giving children positive experiences which will sustain them during the summer and beyond. Volunteers must be mature, work well in a team and be willing to give 100% at all times! Bonus if volunteer has teaching, administrative or youth development experience. Minimum age is 13 and long term volunteers will have to undergo background checks if working directly with children.

- **TRAINING AND SUPERVISION:**

Volunteers will receive general information about Parks & People, the SuperKids Camp Program, and program policies and procedures before starting their commitment. A volunteer training/orientation will be held the week of June, 21<sup>nd</sup> - specific date, time and location TBA. Once on location, the designated site leader will provide a site based training and orientation. Volunteers will be supervised on location by the site leader.



- **TIMES NEEDED & PLACE OF WORK:**

Camp is operational from June 28<sup>th</sup> – August 6<sup>th</sup> Monday – Friday from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. at our various camp site locations. If you would like to assist with administrative matters you should report to our office. We are open 5 days a week from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. at 800 Wyman Park Drive, Suite 010, Baltimore MD 21211.

- **COMMITMENT REQUIRED:** At least four hours for each day you choose to volunteer.

- **BENEFITS:** Free parking, job experience, meet new people, further references, letter and certificate of service, Fun!

- **SATISFACTIONS:** You will undoubtedly leave this experience energized by the impact that your time, no matter how large or small, can have on the attitude and outlook of our children. You will never forget the smiles on their faces, their innocence and their basic desire to have attention from positive role models.
