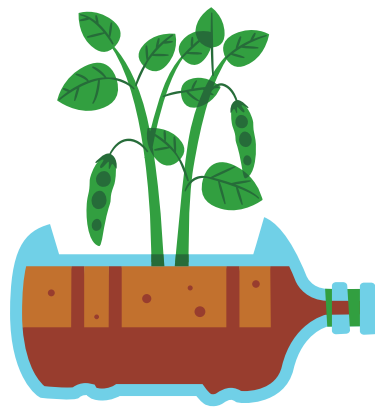

## BRANCHES AT-A-GLANCE



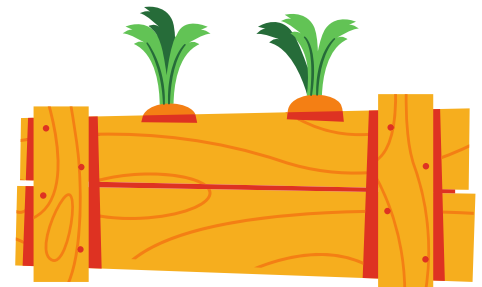
### COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS

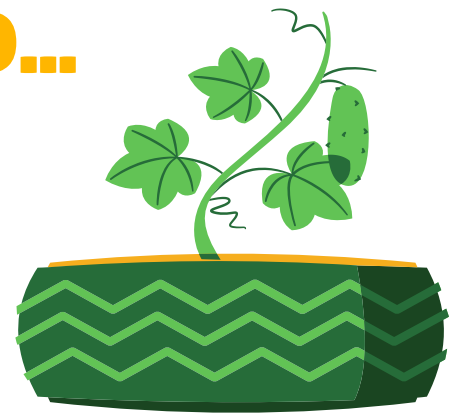
